

Better Catchments in the Mary Catchment



The Better Catchments program (2009 / 11) aims to improve catchment health and on-farm sustainability by managing erosion issues, improving soil health, developing strategic weed control plans and encouraging the adoption of best land management practices across the Mary River Catchment.

The Better Catchments program will build on the achievements of the previous Rivercare, SuperGraze and Better Catchments projects delivered to landholders from 2005 to 2009 by the Mary River Catchment Coordinating Committee (MRCCC).

This program is an initiative of the Burnett Mary Regional Group (BMRG) and funded by the Australian and Queensland Governments through the 'Caring for our Country' Program.

The MRCCC project team will work with local landholders on the following priority actions:

- promoting the implementation of improved soil management practices targeting organic carbon, soil acidification, hillslope erosion etc.
- developing Property Pest Management Plans (PPMPs) for Weeds of National Significance (WoNS) e.g Lantana, and a range of other significant weed plants.
