Cascade treefrog

Scientific Name: *Litoria pearsoniana*

Common Name: Cascade treefrog

Status: (NC(W)R 1994): Vulnerable

Distribution: Coastal ranges in South East Queensland south from about Kandanga.

Habitat: Wet forest streams.

Description: Small frog up to 40mm long. Bright green and/or beige sometimes peppered with black dots. Dark stripe, with an upper border of gold or cream, running from blunt snout through eye to flank.

Habits: Closely associated with water at all times. Nocturnal.

Comments: Found within 2 metres of water on low vegetation.
