All competitors must have a SIPS permit obtainable from tackle shops or online at www.smartservice.qld.gov.au/services/permits/fishing. (NB No permit required if you are under 18 years of age). It is the responsibility of all competitors to abide by all rules and regulations, to fish in a safe and responsible manner, and to dispose of rubbish and used tackle appropriately.
- 2. There will be a limit to number of boats with electric motors permitted to enter the competition.
- 3. Competitors must have a brag mat and camera/smart phone to photograph their catch. Each competitor will be given an icon and a number, to be displayed with the image of the fish to ensure authenticity.
- 4. All fish caught must be released as soon as practicable.
- 5. Winners will be announced at 12.40 pm on Sunday 29th June at the Lake Macdonald Amphitheatre at the Noosa Festival of Water.
