

Clicking froglet *Crinia signifera*

- The three Crinias of this district look very alike (brown and/or grey tones with variable patterning and texture) but can be distinguished by call.
- The Clicking froglet call is a high pitched 'click-ik' often sounding like a game of 'ping-pong' when in a group.
- A very small frog to only 30mm.
- Found often amongst emergent vegetation in swamps and streams.
