- One of our largest Australian frogs to 110mm long.
- Requires deep, slow pools and undercut banks for breeding.
- Lives amongst the leaf litter under riparian (stream-side) vegetation.
- Has suffered declines due to habitat loss and fungal attack.
- Mary River catchment is a stronghold for this species.
